

GNOT 2010 Supplementary Regulations

1. Introduction and eligibility

- 1.1 These regulations supplement the NTBA Tournament Regulations.
- 1.2 The 2010 GNOT NT Trials will be conducted as a three stage event.

Stage 1

Heats in the northern and southern region conducted by affiliates and the NTBA as below.

Heat 1	Arafura BC	Mondays 8 & 15 March
Heat 2	Palmerston BC	Thursdays 15 & 22 April
Heat 3	Darwin BC	Wednesdays 12 & 19 May
Heat 4	NTBA	Saturday 19 June
Heat 5	Alice Springs BC	tba

All heats are to be held in accordance with the NTBA Tournament Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

From each heat one team will qualify through to Stage 2. However, see 2.1.7 below.

Stage 2

Stage 2 will be held as a five team 3-session round robin on the weekend of 21/22 August. The two teams with the highest VP score qualify through to Stage 3.

Stage 3

Stage 3 will be a two team head to head match.

1.3 Eligibility

There are no restrictions on entry to Stage 1.

Contending teams only may play in Stages 2 & 3. For the purposes of this regulation 'contending' implies a commitment to represent the NT at the GNOT in the event of winning Stage 3.

- 1.4 Members of teams that have accepted a place in Stage 2 cannot play in subsequent Stage 1 heats in a contending team. However, they may substitute in a team of at least 4 other players as in NTBA Tournament Regulations 4.3 (ie 1 session only).

1.5 Augmentation

- 1.5.1 Teams of 4 or 5 qualifying for Stage 2, Stage 3 and for the final may augment to teams of 5 or 6. The team is to notify the Chief Tournament Director as soon as the decision is made to augment the team.
- 1.5.2 Substitutes are not allowed in contending teams, except when NTBA Tournament Regulations 4.4 applies.

2. Stage 1 Heats

2.1 Northern Region Heats

- 2.1.1 If affiliate clubs do not wish to run heats 1, 2 and 3, then that heat will be run by the NTBA.
- 2.1.2 For heats run by clubs, the format of each heat is determined by them within the parameters of :
- it is held over 2 sessions
 - the movement is head to head matches of at least 5 boards
 - the club is responsible for management and costs associated with the heat
 - \$3 per player per session will be remitted to the NTBA
 - the heat is held in accordance with the NTBA Tournament Regulations and is concluded by Thursday 29 July
 - results are notified to the Chief Tournament Director for GNOT as soon as possible after they are final, which would normally be the Thursday after the last session
 - results are notified to the State Masterpoint Secretary within two weeks of event.
- 2.1.3 Heat(s) run by the NTBA will each be a 2-session teams event. NTBA heat 4 will be played at Darwin Bridge Club rooms, on Saturday 19 June. Teams of 4, 5 or 6 may enter. The movement for this heat will depend on the number of entries and will be at least 5 boards per match. Cost is \$64 per team per heat. Entries to the NTBA Treasurer or delegate on the Wednesday prior to the heat.
- 2.1.4 Contesting players and teams may elect to
- ◆ play as the same team in different heats
 - ◆ play in only one heat
 - ◆ play with one pair in one heat and another pair in another heat.
- However, see 1.4 above.
- 2.1.5 Posting of results.
The Director should formally post results on the NTBA notice board on the Wednesday following the last session of the heat at 1900 hours (or if unavailable, on a subsequent Wednesday). Results become official at 1200 hours on the following day (and after resolution of any appeals). The Director should notify the Chief Tournament Director (CTD) when this has occurred.
- 2.1.6 Election to contest Stage 2
On the Thursday following the posting of results the Chief Tournament Director (CTD) will invite the Captain of the first placed team to contest Stage 2 (see 1.3 above). If the team declines, or has already won a place from a previous heat, then the CTD will ask the second placed team etc. If the results of 2 heats become official at the same time, then teams are asked in the order of the Heats from which they qualified as in 1.2 above, irrespective of the timing of the final session, posting and finalisation of results etc. If a team declines, then that team will not be asked again in 2010.
- 2.1.7 If no team from a heat accepts the offer to contest Stage 2, or there are no eligible contending teams, then the number of teams contesting Stage 2 is reduced by one.
- 2.1.8 If any heat has only 1 team nominated and that team wishes to contest Stage 2, then entry fees for that heat are payable.

2.2 Southern Region Heat

Alice Springs BC may conduct a Stage 1 heat for the southern region. If this event is held the winning team, or contending team with the highest score, will have the right to one place in Stage 2. \$3 per player per session will be remitted to the NTBA. The heat is to be held in accordance

with the NTBA Tournament Regulations and is to be concluded by Thursday 17 July. Results are to be notified to the Chief Tournament Director for GNOT and the State Masterpoint Secretary as soon as possible after they are final.

3. Stage 2

- 3.1 Stage 2 will be played on Saturday 21 August and Sunday 22 August 2009 as a five team double round robin. If there are not five teams for Stage 2 the NTBA will conduct this in a different format. If there are 4 teams there will be a 3-session 4 team double round robin. With 3 teams, a 2-session double round robin.
- 3.2 Venue is DBC Clubrooms at 43 Parkside Crescent.
- 3.3 There will be 3 sessions:
Session 1: Saturday 21 August 1.15 pm
Session 2: Saturday 21 August 7.15 pm
Session 3: Sunday 22 August TBA, probably 10.00 am.
- 3.4 Entry fee: \$96 per team (\$8/player/session).
- 3.5 Scoring and Movement.
Stage 2 will be played as a 3 session five team double round-robin. Scoring is by VP using the WBF or Groner scales announced by the director at start of play.
- 3.6 The two teams with the highest number of VP's after the completion of Stage 2 qualify to Stage 3.

4. Stage 3

- 4.1 If both contesting teams are both from the Northern Region, Stage 3 will be played on Saturday 18 September 2010, unless the 2 team captains agree otherwise. If an Alice Springs team is in Stage 3, then it will be held in Alice Springs on a date to be negotiated through the Chair of the Tournament Committee.
- 4.2 Session times:
if held on Saturday 18 September:
Session 1: 1.15 pm
Session 2: 7.15 pm.

if an Alice Springs team is in Stage 3 date and times tba.
- 4.4 Entry fee: \$64 per team.
- 4.5 Scoring and Movement
4 x 14 board matches, 2 matches per session. Each match will be scored using imps.

Team seating rights will be determined prior to the start of play.
- 4.6 The team with the highest IMPs score at the end of Stage 3 will represent the NT at the GNOT final.
